# **GENERAL INFORMATION FOR NEW STUDENTS**

#### 1. TRAVELLING TO MASENO UNIVERSITY

Maseno University is situated 25 kilometres north-west of Kisumu town. The University is served by several matatus which operate from Kisumu town. You can take any of them at the bus station in Kisumu town. Matatus bound for Siaya, Luanda and Busia will drop you at the gate of the university campus. Kisumu City Campus College is situated within the Central Business District of Kisumu town, right opposite Kisumu Hotel.

#### 2. IMMIGRATION

All students who are not Kenyan citizens must be in possession of a **VALID PASSPORT BEFORE** arriving in Kenya. Temporary travel documents are not acceptable to the immigration authorities in Kenya. In addition, all non-citizens must obtain re-entry permit from their own territorial immigration department to cover the duration of their course and MUST bring their passport with them when they come to register or sit examinations at the University.

#### 3. LOAN AND BURSARY

Kenyan students who wish to apply for the Kenya Government loan should complete the necessary forms provided by the Higher Education Loans Board. The completed forms should be returned to:
