NOTE:

- PHT 112 HIV AIDS Determinants, Prevention, and Management** shall be offered in the January-April 2023 Semester whereas **AEN 105 Communication Skills** shall be offered in the September- December 2023 semester.

- All other activities, including exam moderation and release of examination results will be done as per the approved Maseno University Trimester Dates for 2022 /2023 Academic Year
- All enquiries on learning content and examination results should be addressed to your School eCampusProgramme Coordinator (ePC)
- The eCampusprogrammes run for **10 weeks (6 hours per week per Module)** to conform to the required unit coverage by the University.
- The HODs are requested through the Deans to float courses for offer on the MIS by 3rd January 2023 to allow students to choose modules and make payment as early as possible. Note that eLearning students only choose a number of courses they have paid for.
